# Sunday School

**8:30 New Class** will be studying *The Scriptures Sing of Advent*. This is a four week study on the songs of praise found in the Scriptures of Christmas. This class will be a beautiful way to celebrate the coming of the Christ child.

**9:30 Fellowship Class** is using a quarterly series meant to orient our minds around the God we worship, while gaining an understanding of God's commitment to us and what our response to that commitment should be. The class will explore our legacy of faith, devotion to God's truth, mentoring others, and setting the example through good works. **Fellowship Classroom Main Building**

**9:30 Searchers Class** is studying *Faith and Reason: Jesus, Faith and Practice* a video and discussion series featuring theologians and laypersons examining applying our faith to real issues in today's society. **Room 103 Discipleship Building**

**9:30 Explorer Bees Class** is making a systematic overview of all the books of the Old Testament. Right now the class is studying the Psalms. This is ideal for persons who feel "new to the Bible" or who wish to deepen their Christian Faith by gaining confidence and familiarity with the overall text of the Bible. **Room 101 Discipleship Building**
